B-Hotel Barcelona

Terrace with a Spanish view

B-Hotel Barcelona has opened a new roof terrace, which can be used for hosting cocktails and tapas. Located on the eighth floor of the hotel, guests can enjoy views of Montjuïc Mountain and the rest of the Spanish city. There is a 120 sqm meeting room that seats up to 120 people and the hotel is located close to the Fira Barcelona convention centre.

Restored and rebranded Swiss hotel

The Hotel Schiller, a historic boutique hotel in Lucerne, Switzerland, has been restored and rebranded as the Renaissance Lucerne Hotel. The hotel, housed in a century-old palace situated in the heart of the city, is located close to Lake Lucerne. Offering 86 bedrooms, the hotel also has 70 sqm of meeting space, with a capacity of 40. It is also located close to the KKL Culture & Convention Center.
